Dear Commissioner Welsh:

Application is hereby made on behalf of **HALCON LOUISIANA OPERATING**, **L.P.** for the calling of a public hearing, after legal notice, to consider evidence relative to the issuance of an order pertaining to the following matters:

- 1. To create one (1) additional drilling and production unit for the exploration for and production of oil and gas from the Tuscaloosa Marine Shale, in the Greenlaw Field, Tangipahoa Parish, Louisiana, said unit to be designated TMS RA SUB, as shown on the plat attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- 2. To force pool and integrate all separately owned tracts, mineral leases and other property interests within the proposed unit with each tract sharing in unit production on a surface acreage basis of participation.
- 3. Except as otherwise provided, to extend to the proposed additional unit all pertinent provisions of the order to be issued by Conservation as a result of a pending application filed on behalf of Goodrich Petroleum Company.
- 4. To consider such others matters as may be pertinent.

The Tuscaloosa Marine Shale, Reservoir A, in the Greenlaw Field, is hereby defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of that oil and gas bearing zone encountered between the depths of 12,620 feet and 13,043 feet (electric log measurements) in the Oxy USA, Inc. – Richland Plantation A No. 1 Well located in Section 69, Township 1 South, Range 2 East, East Feliciana Parish, Louisiana, and is hereby further defined as being the stratigraphic equivalent of the section encountered between the depths of 11,470 feet and 12,000 feet (electric log

measurements) in the Sabine Corporation – Natalbany Lumber Co. Ltd. No. 1 Well, located in Section 15, Township 1 South, Range 6 East, St. Helena Parish, Louisiana.

Any pertinent data, including well logs, not available at the Office of Conservation, may be obtained **AT THE COST OF THE REQUESTING PARTY** from Bill Dale with W. H. Robbins & Associates, L.L.C., 302 LaRue France, Lafayette, Louisiana 70508, Telephone Number (337) 232-5004.

Pursuant to the Rules of Procedure, pre-application notice was given; however, no request for the conference was received. Therefore, the conference tentatively scheduled for July 17, 2014 WILL NOT BE HELD.

Attached hereto and made a part hereof is a plat outlining the applicant's proposal, along with a list of the names and addresses of the Interested Owners, Represented Parties, and Interested Parties to whom a copy of this application is being mailed. Pursuant to the Revised Rules of Procedure, the list of parties is being furnished ONLY to the Commissioner of Conservation and to the District Manager of the Lafayette District of the Office of Conservation; however, the list of parties will be furnished to any party requesting copies. A reasonable effort was made to ascertain the names and addresses of all Interested Owners, Represented Parties and Interested Parties.
